MEL

STELLA

Oh. Right. I guess I should...I guess I should text my partner--

MEL

Your partner was me.

STELLA

Oh. Right.

MEL

So I'm guessing you didn't do your half of the project?

STELLA

Um. The depends. What was I supposed to do?

MEL

Prepare a PowerPoint on Pascal, Descartes, and John Locke.

STELLA

Well I could--

MEL

And write an essay about Edmund Halley.

STELLA

Hm. Yeah. No, okay, I didn't do that.

MEL

Didn't think so.

(exasperated grunt)
Stella, I can't always be the one
keeping track of your life for

you.

STELLA

You don't have to be!

MEL

Clearly I do because you can't seem to remember anything on your own.

STELLA

Hey! I just...I have had a lot on
my mind recently, okay?

MEL

Like what? Because ever since you quit softball AND you dropped Movie Club AND you dropped Journalism, I'm really not sure what you've been so busy with lately.

STELLA

(pause)

Um. Well, my dad--

MEL

Oh. How is--

STELLA

It's been worse.

MEL

Right.

(Pause.)

I'm sorry, Stella.

STELLA

It's okay. You didn't know.

MEL

No. I did.

(beat.)

I'll cover for you okay?

STELLA

What, you're gonna write my essay in the next--

(pauses to check

clock)

--hour and thirty two minutes?

MEL

No. But I bet I can whip up your side of the presentation.

...thanks, Mel.

MEL

Of course. I got your back, girl.
Always have, always will.

NARRATOR

This, of course, was a lie. Mel did not have Stella's back when she was tricked aboard a spaceship by an alien conwoman named Baz. This was, of course, no fault of Mel's. It was because Mel had been killed by two other aliens named Stu and Jerry, and now Stella was utterly alone in the universe as a talking cat threatened to claw out her eyes.

INTRO AND THEME MUSIC

SCENE 2 - THE HALLWAY PT. 2

STELLA

So you guys...you aren't daring space explorers?

BAZ

/Nope

BUTTERCUP

(simultaneous)

/Far from it

STELLA

So what do you...wait. The smell...the flies...the general nastiness. Oh my god. Oh my god!

BAZ

Yeah.

STELLA

You guys transport dead bodies! This is a ship full of dead people! You're...you're intergalactic serial killers! And you're gonna kill me too! BAZ

What? No.

STELLA

No?

BUTTERCUP

Where would you get that idea?

STELLA

It just...I don't know. It seemed like it made sense before I said it.

BUTTERCUP

We're garbage collectors.

STELLA

What?

BUTTERCUP

Garbage collectors.

BAZ

See? I didn't totally lie. We do go all over the galaxy visiting all sorts of fun planets--

BUTTERCUP

Cleaning up their garbage.

STELLA

Oh. Wait. So you used me so that you could get back on a garbage collection ship?

BAZ

Yeah.

STELLA

Why?

BAZ

That's not important.

STELLA

I...don't know if I wanna be
here.

BAZ

C'mon! What do you have to lose?

Ouch.

BAZ

Oh. I didn't mean it like that. Er. Actually yeah, I guess I did.

STELLA

You're bringing that up now? The fact that I lost my entire world? You're bring that up NOW to convince me to play into your scheme?

BAZ

But seriously! Think about it! When I found you, you were ready to give up. And then I gave you a reason to live!

STELLA

Yeah, and it was a lie!

BAZ

But it was still a reason. And I've got plenty more reasons where those came from.

STELLA

Are they lies too?

BAZ

Some of them. But not all.

STELLA

So is everything you say a lie?

BAZ

No! I only lie when it's convenient.

STELLA

And when is it convenient?

BAZ

Almost always.

(beat)

Oh. I see your point. Look, it doesn't matter how I got you here. The point is that you're here now and you're gonna love it. You should meet the rest of the crew!

BUTTERCUP

Baz, you seem to be forgetting that you are not part of the crew, and the interloper you brought on board won't be either.

BAZ

I told the Captain I would find a replacement--

BUTTERCUP

You also told them they'd never have to see you again.

STELLA

Wait, if I'm your replacement, what was your job? What am I replacing?

BAZ

Oh, technically you wouldn't be my replacement.

BUTTERCUP

You'd be the replacement for the guy she killed.

BAZ

I didn't kill anyone!

BUTTERCUP

Yes you did.

BAZ

It's a matter of interpretation.

STELLA

How can that be a matter of interpretation?

BAZ

Was I involved in his death? Yes. But was I responsible for his death? Also yes. But did I intend on his death?

BUTTERCUP

Also yes.

BAZ

Not exactly!

STELLA

Please explain.

THEED

Is that Baz I hear?

NARRATOR

The voice came from around the corner, so Stella didn't see its source at first. When the speaker came around to face the trio, Stella could not help but comment on their appearance.

STELLA

(screams)

THEED

Okay I'll just go then.

STELLA

Sorry, that was rude of me--

BUTTERCUP

No shit.

STELLA

I just-- I'm used to snails being tiny? So seeing you was just a little...shocking.

THEED

It's okay. I'm used to it.

STELLA

You're-- you're, like, a giant snail--

THEED

Actually I'm a regular sized snail. This is just what snails look like.

STELLA

Oh. Right.

THEED

It's okay. I'm just a little self-conscious about my size.

STELLA

I am so sorry.

BAZ

Stella, this is Theed. Theed is our cook.

THEED

Where are you from?

STELLA

I'm from a fictional planet that it turned out was just a 4-billion year simulation devised as a cruel joke.

THEED

Cool.

STELLA

Where are you from?

THEED

Florida.

STELLA

Wait, what?

BAZ

Florida is a tropical planet on the outer rim full of snails. Have you heard of it?

STELLA

Sort of.

BAZ

What do you mean?

The guys who made up my planet...they seem to have built in a lot of inside jokes.

THEED

And what was your Florida?

STELLA

Um. Also a tropical planet full of snails.

THEED

(completely genuine)

How delightful.

BUTTERCUP

Theed-- Baz has used this woman the trick ScottBot into letting her on board.

THEED

Very sneaky.

BUTTERCUP

Yes, and very wrong.

THEED

I don't really see what the problem is.

BUTTERCUP

How do you-- She betrayed us, Theed!

BAZ

That's a little dramatic.

THEED

No that's true actually.

BAZ

Theed! I thought you were on my side!

THEED

I like you. That doesn't mean I'm on your side.

BUTTERCUP

I say we just throw them both off now.

Off? Like, into space?

BUTTERCUP

Sure.

STELLA

Please don't do that.

BUTTERCUP

You called me cute!

STELLA

THEED

BUTTERCUP

They don't need to know. They don't want to know.

THEED

BUTTERCUP

STELLA

What did Sid do?

BUTTERCUP

Sid was the Poker.

STELLA

Okay. Cool.

(beat)

What is a Poker?

BUTTERCUP

(to Theed)

She doesn't even know about the Poker.

THEED

Hm. Maybe we should throw her off then.

STELLA

Hey!

THEED

Actually no, we can't do that.

STELLA

Thank you.

THEED

There's always organ traffickers.

BUTTERCUP

Good point.

STELLA

Um...please don't sell my organs.

BUTTERCUP

Now who's cute, bitch!

STELLA

I'm sorry I called you cute, okay! Just please don't...I'd like to stay alive, please.

BAZ

Me as well. For what it's worth.

BUTTERCUP

You don't get a vote. This woman, on the other hand-- sorry, what's your name?

STELLA

Stella.

BUTTERCUP

THEED

BUTTERCUP

No one cares, Theed.

THEED

THEED

SCENE 3 - LOUNGE

NARRATOR

Prior to the advent of garbage collection, the universe was a very stinky place. It still is, but now most of that stink is concentrated in the cargo hold of the Starship Raccoon.

Many starships that travel from planet to planer doing odd jobs develop a bit of a reputation for themselves. The Starship Raccoon was not one of those starships, despite doing one of the oddest jobs out there. It was, unfortunately the kind of job most people liked to ignore, and it wasn't as though they were particularly good at it. BAZ

I don't even want to know.

THEED

Hi Gerald.

GERLAD

Oh. Hi. Want some peanuts?

BAZ

Oh, Stella, here's another member of the crew, Gerald. He's our main trash collector and also our janitor.

STELLA

Oh. We've met.

GERALD

Have we?

STELLA

Yes. Three times now. How do you not remember?

GERALD

("I don't know" sound)

I meet a lot of people.

BAZ

Gerald is not the friendliest guy on the crew.

PUPPET

I am, actually. I ranked us based on all of our best and worst qualities.

STELLA

(surprise)

Oh!

(she sees him)

OH.

NARRATOR

Stella turned around to see what looked like a giant marionette with no strings. He looked as if Pinnochio had finally given up on becoming a real boy and just decided to grow up and become a wooden man. He bore the same rumpled blue jumpsuit as the rest of the crew, but his wooden face was painted like the goat herd from the Sound of Music.

BUTTERCUP

That's Puppet.

PUPPET

That's not my real name.

BAZ

But we don't actually know his real name, so we call him Puppet.

STELLA

Is it because he looks like--

BUTTERCUP

Because he's an android made of wood, yes.

THEED

But it's also a little joke on our part because he's our pilot. He looks like a puppet...

BUTTERCUP

But he's a puppeteer.

PUPPET

Ranked most friendly, most talented, second least likely to commit homicide, third most competent--

STELLA

You ranked yourself third?

PUPPET

Well I didn't want to lie.

PUPPET
